

I am pleased to announce that the 2009 Frazier/Mason Some Gave All Memorial Ride was a resounding success. An estimated 1,000 motorcycles take part in the ride from Spotsylvania High School, where Josh Frazier attended, to King George High School, where Nick Mason attended. The ride was preceded by a pre-ride ceremony at Spotsylvania High School. The ride was fully escorted by Spotsylvania and Stafford Mounted (motorcycle) Deputies and assisted by the King George Sheriff Department. A crowd of between 1,500 and 2,000 at King George High School was entertained by 2 bands, the 540 Boyz performing stunts on motorcycles and 4 wheelers, Spotsylvania and Stafford officers performing synchronized slow riding through a series of cones, a moon bounce for the kids, a patriotic bike show and wonderful variety of foods provided by a number of vendors. The ceremony which began at 2:00 PM was kicked off by a beautiful rendition of "Amazing Grace" performed on bag pipes. Representative Robb Wittman, CDR Dennis Quick and Delegate Albert Pollard were the guest speakers. **It was our pleasure to present McGuire Medical Center for Veterans with a check in the amount of \$10,000 to be used to send disabled veterans to the Wheelchair Games.** The ceremony was concluded with a Roll Call of the Fallen from our area, the Benediction by Ret. General Koehler and taps was played to end the ceremony.
